

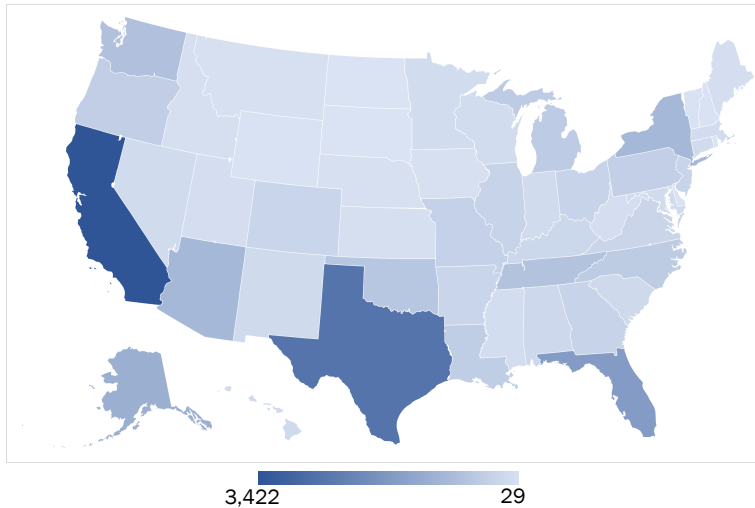
Unresolved Missing Persons Cases Published in NamUs Bi-Annual Report - January 2024

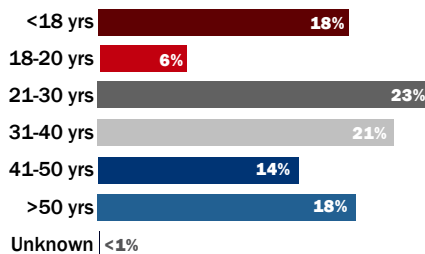

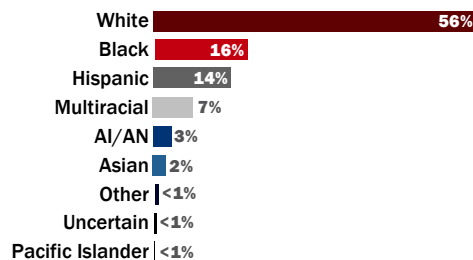
Sex Assigned at Birth

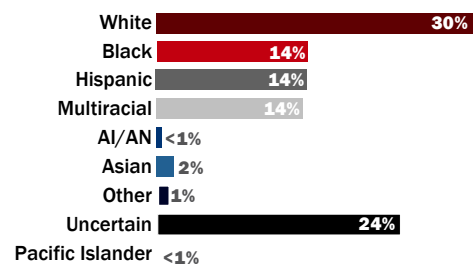
Age of Case

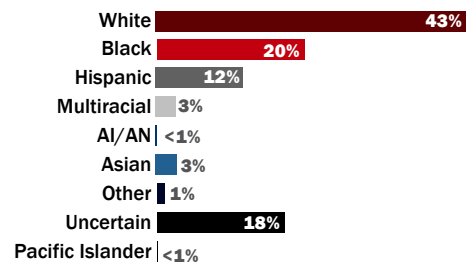
Sex Assigned at Birth

Sex Assigned at Birth

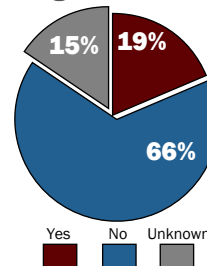


Age When Reported Missing

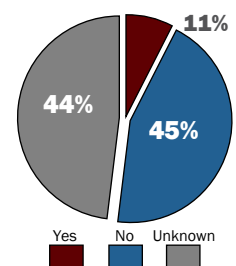

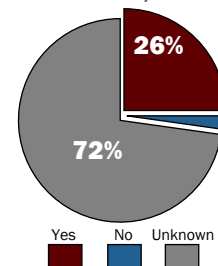
Missing from Tribal Land*

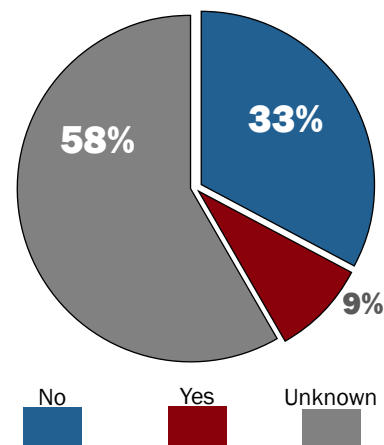

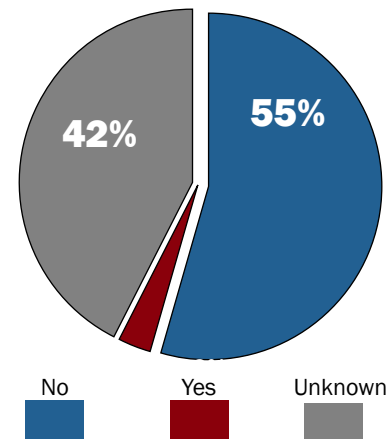


Sex Assigned at Birth
