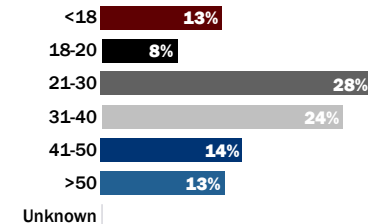

#### Sex Assigned at Birth

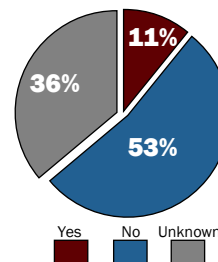


#### Age at Time of Missing

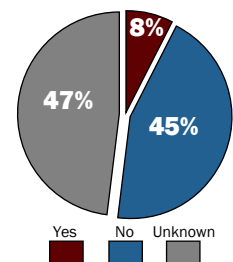

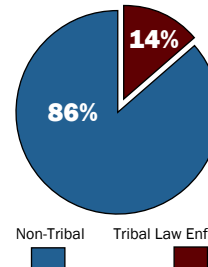
#### Missing from Tribal Land\*



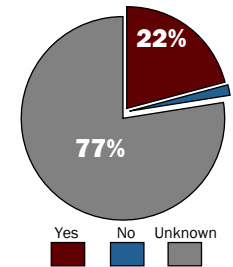
#### Residence on Tribal Land\*
