The Missing Persons Unit (MPU) at INTERPOL Washington is dedicated to leveraging its resources, technology, and expertise to assist law enforcement agencies and families in locating missing individuals.

OUR NETWORK

MPU collaborates with INTERPOL's global network of 196 member countries, law enforcement agencies, and international partners to share information, coordinate efforts, and enhance crossborder cooperation in locating missing persons.

OUR ACCESS

MPU provides access to INTERPOL's extensive databases, which contain information on DNA, unidentified bodies, fingerprints, facial recognition, and more. These data bases assist to quickly match and ID individuals, helping reunite families and ensure justice.

OUR EXPERIENCE

We leverage the INTERPOL Washington team of experts in various fields, including law enforcement. These professionals provide specialized support and guidance to law enforcement agencies working on missing persons cases.





Yellow Notices are issued to help locate missing persons, often minors, or to help identify persons who are unable to identify themselves.



Black Notices are an INTERPOL alert issued to police worldwide to seek information about unidentified bodies.



INTERPOL's I-Familia service provides the necessary international mechanism to allow missing persons DNA data to be compared globally.
