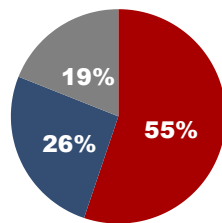

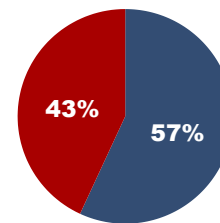

Age on Date of Disappearance

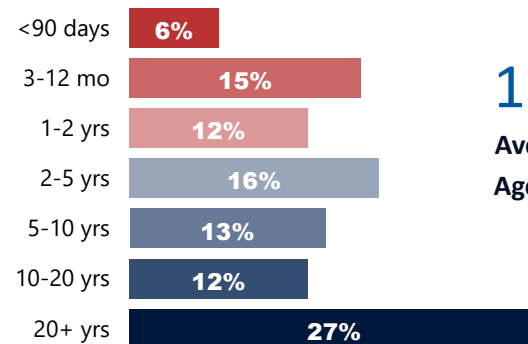

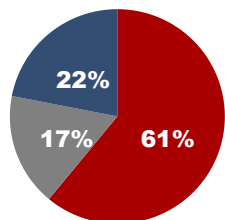

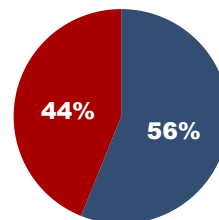

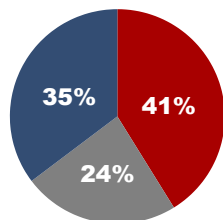

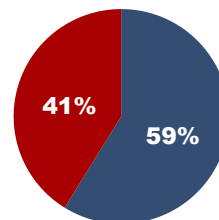

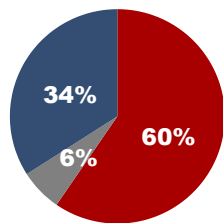

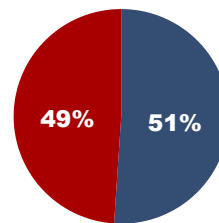

Age on Date of Disappearance

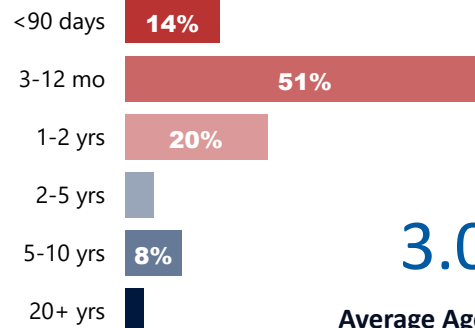

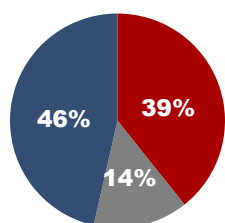

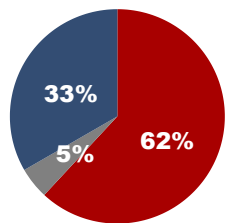

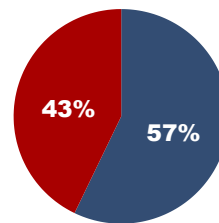

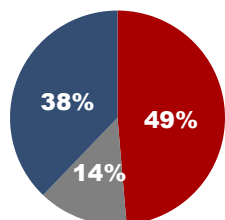

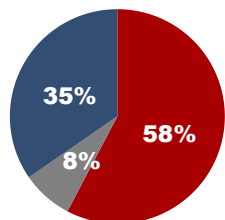

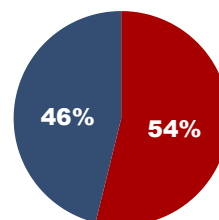
