







### Unresolved Missing Persons Cases Published in NamUs Bi-Annual Report - June 2024

\*This series of reports contains information only on individuals who have been reported as missing, unidentified, or unclaimed to NamUs; it does not include information on all missing, unidentified, and unclaimed persons nationwide. ### 17,266 Unclaimed Cases from 42 States and Territories














